Volunteers provide a service for candidates and young people within GCCF YES!

To assist the GCCF in providing a safe environment and a positive climate, volunteers are asked to comply with this Code of Conduct. This Code of Conduct has been formulated to clarify the type of conduct that is expected of volunteers participating in YES!

- You are expected, as a volunteer to be honest, fair and respect other candidates and young people and work to the best standard of your ability.
- You, as a volunteer have a special duty of care for any candidate or young persons you are working with.
- You, as a volunteer needs to appreciate that the candidates and young people have rights and aspirations, always treat them with dignity and respect.
- Volunteers should not discuss nor disclose personal information about candidates or young people, their families or guardians.
- Volunteers are expected to observe safe practices which in turn will avoid any unnecessary risks.
- Volunteers should report any problems as they arise immediately to the Safeguarding Lead or Deputy who will ensure that the Show Manager concerned is aware.
